




Haiti Help & Hope

Culdee Church has been a supportive partner for some time, of the Christian work of Pastor Dortul Sidor in Montrouis, Haiti. An urgent need has come to our attention, and our Session has given its blessing to an appeal for funds to help meet this need. Due to the ongoing unstable situation in Haiti and increasing gang dominance and violence, the Lahai Roi School has been employing security guards and has begun constructing a wall around the school property. Pastor Sidor has asked for financial assistance for this building project, which will help protect the school and its staff and students; and which will also provide employment for local workers. Pastor Sidor and his wife Lillian are known in their area as humble servants of Christ who often go without in order to help others. In his words, "because we are dwelling in the shelter of the Most High, we are still alive and well; and truly, our ministries are doing well and growing."

If you would like to contribute to the construction of the protective wall around the school in Haiti, you may do so by writing a check to Culdee Church and noting that it is for the Lahai Roi School Project.

2023 Budget:


